County Road Update – July 19, 9:00 p.m.

The County of Grande Prairie has re-opened TWP 742 from RR 62 to RR 63. The road was closed due to heavy rainfall and subsequent flooding. Crews continue to work throughout the County to re-open roads washed out or damaged by heavy rain.

Road Conditions

The following County roads remain closed:

- RR 114 between Secondary Highway 672 and TWP 734
- RR 125 between Secondary Highway 672 and TWP 734
- RR 123 between TWP 734 and Secondary Highway 672
- TWP 730A between RR 123 and RR 121
- RR 115 from Secondary Highway 672 to TWP 730
- RR 123 from Secondary Highway 672 to TWP 734
- TWP 744 east of Highway 2 to RR 52 (local traffic only allowed)
- TWP 754 from RR 90 to RR 92
- TWP 744 east of RR 65
- RR 65 south of TWP 744
- RR 61 south of TWP 744

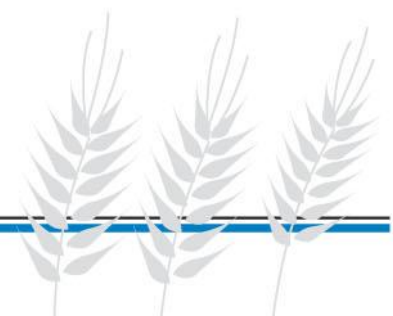
Park Conditions

Bear Lake Day Use parking lot and boat launch remain closed to the public until further notice. All other County parks have been re-opened.
