Applications will be accepted until 4:30pm Thursday, September 15th.

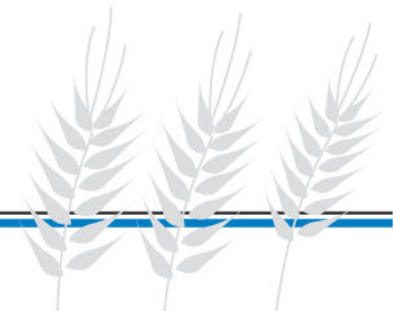
No experience is required. Applicants must be willing to train to NFPA 1001 Level 2 certification.
