The County thanks everyone who participated in the photo contest. The winning pictures can be viewed at www.countygp.ab.ca/photocontest. All photos entered in the photo contest throughout the year will be available for viewing at the 14th Annual Photo Contest Evening being held in March 2018.

The Fan Favourite portion of the Summer Photo Contest will begin at 11 a.m. on Thursday, October 12. The top photos from the summer phase will be posted to the County’s Facebook Page at www.facebook.com/cogp1. The public will have until 11 a.m. on October 26, 2017 to like their favourite photo(s). The photos that get the most likes will be announced and awarded with prizes at the Photo Contest Evening in 2018.

The fall phase of the contest is underway and will run until November 30, 2017. Photographers of all levels, hobbyists and archivists are encouraged to enter the contest.

The County and Watson’s are currently accepting photos in the following categories. All photos must be fall themed and taken within the County of Grande Prairie; however, do not have to be taken in 2017:

1. People Engaged in Sports, Recreation and Culture in the County – photos of people actively engaged in various indoor and outdoor activities such as camping, hunting, golfing, ATV and dirt biking, hiking, biking, fishing, sporting events, concerts, parades, festivals, etc.



2. Scenes of the County – Photos of site specific scenes within the County of Grande Prairie such as the Philip J. Currie Dinosaur Museum, South Peace Centennial Museum, parks, campgrounds, Sportsplex, etc.
3. People at work – Photos of people actively engaged in work such as construction sites, office settings, oilfield, farming, etc.
4. People Engaged in Agriculture – Photos of people actively engaged in agriculture such as – combining, swathing, seeding, gardening, ranch and animal work, 4-H functions, etc.

For each phase the prizes for each category are:

- 1st place: \$ 100.00 gift certificate for Watson's Foto Source
- 2nd place: \$ 50.00 gift certificate for photo finishing at Watsons' Foto Source
- 3rd place: \$ 25.00 gift certificate for photo finishing at Watson's Foto Source

Judging and prize awarding will take place at the end of each phase. Prizes may not be awarded if a category lacks qualified entries.

A grand prize winner for each of the categories will be selected at the Photo Contest Evening in 2018. Each Grand Prize winner will be awarded a \$250 gift certificate to Watson's Foto Source and a 12" by 18" metal print of their winning photo, courtesy of the County of Grande Prairie. The overall winning photos will be showcased at the Crosslink County Sportsplex.

All contestants will also receive a voucher from Watson's Foto Source to develop 25 prints, free of charge.

The County retains the right to use and publish all photos, and will give the photographer credit when possible when their photo is used.
