Upgrades to Township Road 730 from Range Road 51 west to Range Road 52 underway

Contractors have begun upgrading Township Road 730/Mercer Hill from Range Road 51 west to Range Road 52. The upgrades involves contractors basing the road, which is digging out the top section, and paving it. The anticipated completion date of these projects is early August, weather permitting.

Over the duration of this project, traffic may experience delays. Speed will be reduced in the construction zones. As well, traffic may be reduced to a single alternating lane. Motorists are advised to obey all signs, flag persons, exercise extreme caution when travelling through the site and near crews and equipment, and allow extra time for travel.

Please note that start and completion dates are weather dependent.

The County is investing a total of \$34.4 million in 2017 on capital road projects, and an additional \$20 million over 2017 and 2018 on road improvements in all nine divisions of the County.
