Snow removal update #2

Snow removal crews made significant progress clearing roads this weekend.

“If the weather continues to cooperate we should have approximately 95% of our roads open today,” stated Dale Van Volkingburgh, Public Works Director. “Some roadways continue to be one lane and banks are high on the side of roads so motorists should use caution.”

The County thanks residents and drivers for their patience under these extreme circumstances.

Crews will be clearing driveways for seniors and physically disabled who receive snowplow services through the Seniors Snow Plow Program once all major, arterial and collector roads are cleared, as per the County’s snow removal policy.
