### Update #33 – County road closures and re-openings

The County has updated its list of road closures. The most recent road closure is:

Township Road 705 has water crossing in areas so use extreme caution when travelling in this area. The recommended alternate route is Township Road 720.

A number of pedestrian trails in the County are submerged due to spring runoff. Pedestrian trails in the Hamlet of Clairmont, especially those in the area of Clairmont Lake are in the process of being submerged or have been fully submerged. Individuals are being asked to avoid the area. Members of the public are asked to exercise extreme caution on trails throughout the County, especially with children and pets, as conditions can change rapidly.

Staff continues to monitor the impacts of spring runoff and provide updates as information becomes available. Motorists should use extreme caution, especially during the night, as road conditions can change rapidly.
