### **Snow removal underway on County roads**

Snow removal crews are working to clear drifting snow from the County's 3,600 km road network.

Crews are clearing local gravel and rural roads as a priority. The County has hired extra equipment and will be working extended hours to clear all rural roads as quickly as possible. Multiple snow fall events and inclement weather may alter the snow clearing cycle.

Drivers are also advised to remember the following:

- Slow down and adjust your driving to the changing environment and road conditions
- Keep your vehicle, especially windows and mirrors, clear of snow and ice
- Drive with your headlights on
- Avoid sudden moves
- Leave enough room between you and the vehicle you are following

The County thanks residents and drivers for their patience as we work to clear snow and ice from roads.
