Snow removal efforts underway on County roads

Snow removal crews are working at full capacity to clear snow from over 3,600 km of County roads.

Crews are clearing main paved roads as a priority; followed by arterial and local gravel roads.

The crews dedicated to snow removal in County hamlets has begun clearing roads in Clairmont north of 108 Avenue. Later this week and once roads in Clairmont north of 108 Ave are complete, the crew will clear roads in the hamlet of La Glace, and Clairmont south of 108 Avenue, which includes the subdivisions of Whispering Ridge and Westlake Village. Once this area is complete, the crew will move onto the subdivision of Wedgewood.

Residents are advised to watch for snow removal crews in their neighbourhood and ensure their vehicles are not parked on the roadside while crews are at work clearing streets. As well, residents are advised to not pile or push snow from their driveways or property onto the roads as it slows the snow clearing process and creates a traffic safety hazard.

Crews will be clearing driveways for seniors and physically disabled who receive snowplow services through the Seniors Snow Plow Program once major, arterial and collector roads have been cleared, as per the County's snow removal policy.

Please note that the snow removal schedule is tentative and there may be changes to the schedule in unforeseen circumstances. For more information about the snow removal procedure in the County, visit www.countygp.ab.ca/roadmaintenance.
