### **County Snow Removal Schedule Update**

Snow removal crews are working at full capacity to clear snow from over 3,600 km of County roads.

Crews are clearing main paved roads as a priority; followed by arterial and local gravel roads.

The crews dedicated to snow removal in County hamlets have completed the roads in the subdivision of Westlake Village in Clairmont and are now clearing roads in Whispering Ridge in Clairmont. Once this area is complete, crews will move to Wedgewood, followed by residential areas in Clairmont north of 100 Avenue.

Residents are advised to watch for snow removal crews in their neighbourhood and ensure their vehicles are not parked on the roadside while crews are at work clearing streets. As well, residents are advised to not pile or push snow from their driveways or property onto the roads as it slows the snow clearing process and creates a traffic safety hazard.
