Officers Conduct Spot Inspections

On May 14th and 15th Peace Officer's from County and City Enforcement, County RCMP Enhanced Police, County Public Works and Aquatera got together to promote safety, education and enforcement on the roads into three local landfill sites.

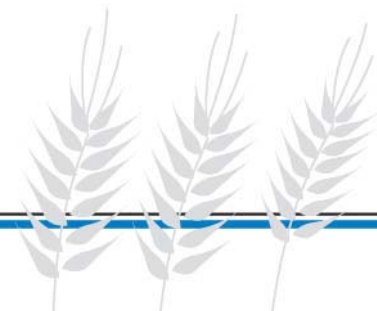
County Peace Officers were stationed at the Clairmont Recycling & Waste Management Centre and West County Regional site while City Peace Officers worked at the Aquatera landfill.

445 vehicles were inspected at the two County locations. While Peace Officers conducted the vehicles and load checks, staff from Aquatera and County Public Works Environmental Services met with motorists and handed out public information flyers.

Overall, compliance was noted to be very good.
