County Parks Officially Open This Week

All parks in the County open May 12th. The County's parks offer a variety of recreational activities, including camping, hiking, canoeing, swimming, picnicking and wildlife viewing.

The County owns and operates 8 parks and campground facilities within its boundaries. Campgrounds offering overnight camping include Pipestone Creek, Hommy, Kleskun, Demmitt, Bear Lake, Red Willow and Valhalla. Saskatoon Mountain Park is open for day use activities only.

Fees in the campgrounds have not changed this year. They are \$20 per unit/night for each campsite at Pipestone Creek, \$15 at Demmitt, Kleskun Hill, Hommy, and Bear Lake and there is no charge at Valhalla or Red Willow.

The County only accepts bookings for the group area at Pipestone Creek. All other campsites are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
