New Meeting for Wapiti Corridor Planning Society

The Wapiti Corridor Planning Society is holding a public meeting at the TEC Centre at Evergreen Park on Thursday January 28th, 2010 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

“This meeting provides the opportunity for stakeholders to see the significant progress the Society has made since the last public meeting” said President Jim Smith. “This is the first of several opportunities for people to talk to the Consultant who was hired to create a multi-use plan” he said.

The goal of the Wapiti Corridor Planning Society is to create a multi-use vision, plan and recommendations for the Wapiti River Valley from Pipestone Creek to the Smoky River that accommodates, protects and balances both the current and future needs of the area and its people.

“This meeting will also provide the opportunity for those who haven’t had a chance to give their opinion on the plan, or have something to add to the information they’ve already shared with the Society,” stated Smith. “The Wapiti Corridor Planning Society cannot create a plan without input from stakeholders. Input from stakeholders on issues, concerns and solutions are essential”.

The Wapiti Corridor Planning Society is a stakeholder driven initiative, looking at creating a plan to manage the land uses along the north and south sides of the Wapiti River. They are looking for user groups, industry representatives, landowners, etc. to provide their input into the process and plan. Interested parties are invited to attend the above noted meeting. The Society held their last public meeting in March, 2009.
