

# COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

August 21, 2017

**Public Hearings** – Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-17-020 to redesignate 9.98 acres of land located 6 ½ miles southeast of the Hamlet of Elmworth, adjacent to Rge Rd 110 from an Agricultural (AG) District to allow for the subdivision of one country residential lot. Council gave the bylaw third reading.

Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-17-024 to redesignate 18.60 acres of land located 5 miles south of the Hamlet of Dimsdale, adjacent to Rge Rd 74 and Twp Rd 704 from an Agricultural (AG) District to a Country Residential (CR-2) District to allow for the subdivision of three country residential lots. Council gave the bylaw third reading.

Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-17-026 to redesignate 13.9 acres of land located 5 ½ miles northwest of Teepee Creek and adjacent to Rge Rd 42 from Agricultural (AG) District to a Country Residential (CR-5) to allow for the subdivision of one country residential lot. Council gave the bylaw third reading.

Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-17-027 to redesignate 25.25 acres of land located adjacent to the southwest of the Town of Sexsmith, and Rge Rd 62 and Hwy 672 from Agricultural (AG) District to Rural Medium Industrial (RM-2) District to allow for the subdivision of two medium industrial lots; as well as redesignate 5 acres of land from an Agricultural (AG) District to Highway Industrial (RM-4) District to allow for the subdivision of one highway industrial use lot. Council gave the bylaw third reading.

**Wembley Co-op Seed Cleaning Association Funding Request** – Wade Perrin of the Wembley Co-op Seed Cleaning Association requested the County cover 50 per cent of the approximately \$300,000 cost to expand the seed cleaning plant, which would involve developing the north of the seed plant, burying power lines, installing new seed bins and installing a new 30m truck scale. Council forwarded this request to 2018 interim budget for deliberation and requested the Association provide cost estimates for the project.

**Employee Achievements** – Council and staff congratulated Carey Moulun, Public Works Administrative Assistant on her completion of the Essential Skills for Administrative Professionals Certificate.

**Equipment Replacement Units for 2018** – Council approved the advancement of the bid solicitation process for the replacement of units identified on the 2018 Equipment Replacement Units Schedule.

**Request for Proposal** – Council awarded the request for proposal for Kal Tire to supply tires and provide tire services from August 2017 to August 2019 with the option to extend the contract for one additional year.
