2017-2018 Additional Road Construction Program Borrowing Bylaw

– Council gave Borrowing Bylaw 3065 third reading which will allow funds to be borrowed to complete an additional \$20 million in road improvement projects in all nine of the County's divisions over the next two years. Town of Sexsmith Funding Request – Council approved an additional contribution of up to \$40,132.94 to go towards the Town of Sexsmith's new fire hall. The County of Grande Prairie's has contributed a total of \$542,132.94 to the project to date.

Family and Community Support Services Day Proclamation –

Council proclaimed June 17, 2017 as Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) Day in the County of Grande Prairie. In celebration of FCSS Day, the County will be hosting an old-fashioned family picnic and games day at Saskatoon Lake Community Hall on Saturday, June 17 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., which is free for the public to attend. Public Hearings – Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-016-069 to redesignate 28.43 acres of land located approx. 6 ½ miles east of the Village of Hythe and 8 ½ miles north of the Town of Beaverlodge, adjacent to Hwy 723 from Agricultural (AG) District to Country Residential (CR-5) District to allow for the subdivision of one residential lot. Council gave the Bylaw first and second reading. The application will be brought back at the next Public Hearing for third and final reading.

Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-017-017 to redesignate 9.88 acres of land located approx. 7 ½ miles south east of the Hamlet of Elmworth, adjacent to Rge Rd 105 from Agricultural (AG) District to Country Residential (CR-5) to allow for the subdivision of one residential lot. Council gave the bylaw third reading.

Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-017-018 to redesignate 9.89 acres of land located approx. 6 miles southeast of the Hamlet of Elmworth, adjacent to Rge Rd 110 from Agricultural (AG) District to Country Residential (CR-5) to allow for the subdivision of one residential lot. Council gave the bylaw third reading.

Council held a public hearing for Bylaw 2680-017-019 to redesignate 12.2 acres of land located approx. 6 miles northwest of the Hamlet of La Glace, adjacent to Rge Rd 84 and Twp Rd 750 from Agricultural (AG) District to Country Residential (CR-5) District to allow for the subdivision of one residential lot. Council gave the bylaw third reading.

Bylaws – Council gave the bylaw to license environmental reserve lands to the Aspen Ridge Community Association first reading.

Grande Prairie Regional College Degree Granting Status – Council will write a letter to the Alberta Minister of Education and include Minister McQuaig-Boyd, local MLAs, Grande Prairie Regional College (GPRC) President, and GPRC Centre for Research and Innovation Director, expressing their support for GPRC's degree granting status request.

Alberta Municipal Water and Wastewater Partnership – Council will write a letter to Alberta Minister of Infrastructure and Transportation following up on the Clairmont Regional Lift Station project and requesting to meet with the Minister for clarification of funding potential.

Climate and Asset Management Network Grant – Council passed a resolution to participate in and apply for the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Climate and Asset Management Network (CAMN) grant program. CAMN provides a combination of peer learning opportunities, and funding and training activities that occur in two phases. Grant funding of up to \$175,000 is available.

FCSS Building Needs Committee – Council made a motion to expand the scope of the County FCSS Building Needs Committee to consider space needs for the entire organization over a 10 year and 20 year time horizon with the main purpose and priority of the committee continuing to be finding a new and permanent space for the FCSS department.

Contributions – Council approved supplying lunch valued up to \$400 for the Grande Prairie Regional Tourism Association's monthly meeting taking place at the Philip J. Currie Dinosaur Museum on June 15, 2017.

Next Council meeting will take place on June 19, 2017.
