## **County Fire Service responds to structure fire in Bezanson; rescue Wedgewood man overcome by carbon monoxide fumes**

At approximately 12:15 p.m., County Fire Service responded to a fully involved residential structure fire on Range Road 32 south of Bezanson.

County Fire Service responded with 22 fire fighters from the Bezanson, Teepee Creek, and Dunes stations.

There were no injuries reported and the cause of the fire is under investigation.

Just after 5 p.m., firefighters from the Dunes station responded within minutes to a Carbon Monoxide (CO) call in Wedgewood. A woman called 911 stating that a man was nonresponsive in a home after a car was accidentally left running in a garage. On arrival one resident was found outside the home and assessed. Crews masked up with breathing apparatus and entered the residence where they found a male unconscious on the living room floor. Once safely evacuated, they administered oxygen and provided medical assistance until EMS arrived and transported the patient to the hospital.

Firefighters monitored the air in the home and found readings in excess of 200 parts per million. Fire crews remain on scene ventilating the residence.
