Crack sealing on County paved roads commencing

Today, the County will begin crack sealing all paved County roads for the remainder of the summer season.

Motorists are advised to slow down near and when in construction zones; watch for construction workers, equipment and flaggers crossing the road; and to obey all signs as posted.

“The County remains committed to improving and maintaining our infrastructure—after all, it plays a key role in the healthy and sustainable growth of our region,” says Herb Pfau, County Public Works Superintendent.

Crack sealing is one of various County’s construction projects. The County has invested \$28.5 million (\$18.8 million in new projects and \$ 9.7 million carried over from 2012) on road construction and infrastructure projects for 2013
