County hosting Dimsdale Area Structure Plan Public Input Sessions Thursday

The County will host two public input sessions at the Dimsdale Community Hall for Dimsdale residents and businesses on Thursday, May 9th from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

During these sessions, County staff will present three proposed land-use concepts and maps for the Dimsdale Area Structure Plan (ASP).

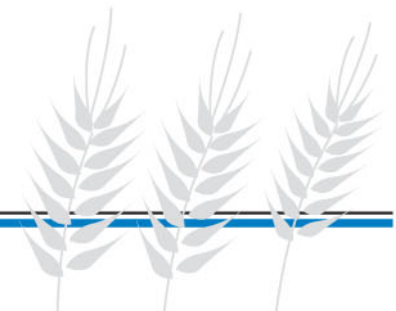
“We encourage all Dimsdale residents and businesses to attend these sessions so that they can gain more information about the land-use concept, provide County staff with constructive feedback, and vote for their preferred land-use concept,” says Nick Lapp, County Senior Planner. “Additionally, other County departments will be available to answer any questions related to the Dimsdale ASP.”

After all feedback and votes are received on the proposed concepts, the County will narrow down the concepts to the most suitable one, refine and then develop a land-use policy around it.

Prior to these public input sessions, public consultations and two open houses for Dimsdale and area residents and landowners were held. The County Planning and Development department and consultants Kairos Creative Solutions Inc. used the information gathered at these consultations to help develop three land-use concepts and maps.

The Dimsdale Community Hall is located 3 kilometres south of Range Road 72A off Highway 43 west.

Complementary snacks and refreshments will be served at the morning session; and free refreshments, barbecued burgers and hot dogs at the evening session.
