### **Ammonia Anhydrous Leak Contained**

An ammonia anhydrous leak on a farm property near LaGlance temporarily closed down a local road Tuesday night.

Fire crews from Clairmont, LaGlance, and Sexsmith along with RCMP, AHS and Viterra responded to a 9-1-1 call shortly after 11 p.m.

The leak from a wagon-style vessel released 1750 gallons of the hazardous material. One resident was evacuated from the area and Range Road 84 was closed as a precaution. The leaking tank was in an open area so no further evacuations were necessary.

The cause of the leak is under investigation. A heavy odor of ammonia anhydrous may be present for the next few hours.
