### Snow removal efforts underway on County roads

Snow removal crews are working at full capacity to clear snow from the County's 3,600 km road network.

Crews are clearing main paved roads as a priority; followed by arterial and local gravel roads.

The crew dedicated to snow removal in County hamlets will finish clearing snow from roads in Clairmont north of 100 Avenue today. Once this area is complete, the crew will move onto the subdivisions of Whispering Lake and Westlake in Clairmont and after those areas are completed, Wedgewood.

Residents are asked to watch for snow removal crews in their neighbourhood and ensure that vehicles are not parked on the roadside while crews clear streets.

As well, residents are advised to not pile or push snow from their driveways or property onto the roads as it slows the snow clearing process and creates a traffic safety hazard.

Please note that the snow removal schedule is tentative and there may be changes to the schedule in unforeseen circumstances. For more information about the snow removal procedure in the County, visit [www.countygp.ab.ca/roadmaintenance](http://www.countygp.ab.ca/roadmaintenance).
