County Regional Fire Service Recruiting Paid On Call Firefighters at Clairmont and Dunes Fire Stations

Individuals that are self-motivated, team-oriented, community-minded and possess their NFPA certification are encouraged to apply by July 13, 2018 to become a paid on call firefighter at the Clairmont and Dunes fire stations.

“This is a great opportunity for individuals to continue a career in firefighting in a part time capacity, make a difference in the community and work in a positive team atmosphere for one of the largest and most comprehensive fire services in the Peace Region,” said Dan Verdun, Fire Chief.

Minimum requirements for all recruits are as follows:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have a current, class 3 Alberta Driver's License with airbrake endorsement
- Clean driver's abstract and safe driving record
- Possess a Grade 12 education
- Pass RCMP Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check
- NFPA 1001 Level 2 certification
- NFPA 1002 Pump A certification
- Recognized Emergency Medical Responder (EMR), Medical First Responder or higher
- Aptitude for physically demanding but rewarding work
- Positive, team-oriented attitude
- A minimum commitment of 48 hours (four shifts) per month

The benefits of working as a paid on call firefighter for the County Regional Fire Service include Workers Compensation Board coverage, life insurance coverage, continued education and hands on experience.
