County snow removal underway in Wedgewood and Maple Ridge on Wednesday

A temporary parking ban has been issued for the County subdivision of Wedgewood as crews dedicated to snow removal have begun working in the area.

Once residential snow clearing has been completed in Wedgewood, crews are expected to move on to the subdivisions of Maple Ridge by late Wednesday afternoon and Taylor Estates by Thursday.

County residents are reminded that temporary parking restrictions are in effect for areas where snow removal crews are working or will begin work within the next 24 hours.

The County has installed new signage at the entrances to specific County neighbourhoods and will be revealed 24-hours prior to crews working in the area. When the No Parking sign is visible, parking on roadways is not permitted. Residents are also reminded to not pile or push snow from their driveways or property onto the roads as it slows the snow clearing process and creates a traffic safety hazard.

Please note that the snow removal schedule is tentative and there may be changes to the schedule in unforeseen circumstances. For more information about the snow removal procedure in the County, visit www.countygp.ab.ca/roadmaintenance.
