Early morning fire near Elmworth

At approximately 7:52 a.m. this morning, the Beaverlodge, Hythe and Wembley fire departments responded to a reported structure fire, located six miles southwest of the Hamlet of Elmworth.

Upon arrival, crews found a residential dwelling fully engulfed. The responding departments suppressed and began extinguishing the fire. The County's La Glace and Bezanson fire stations provided two additional water tenders, which are specialized firefighting vehicles that transport large volumes of water, to the scene.

No one was injured as a result of the fire.

Crews remain on scene to continue extinguishing the fire. County Regional Fire Service's Fire Marshall is also on scene and the cause of the fire is currently under investigation.
