Road Grading begins today on Range Road 64

Road grading will be starting today on a 1.6 km section of Range Road 64, north of Township Road 710 (also known as the Correction Line).

The work is expected to take until Friday to complete, weather dependent.

During construction traffic will be reduced to a single alternating lane. Motorists are advised to obey all signs, flag persons, exercise extreme caution when travelling through the site and near crews and equipment and allow extra time for travel.

The County is investing a total of \$31.1 million on capital road and bridge projects this year. New construction this year includes 18.4 km of road surfacing including the paving of gravel roads, surfaced road overlays, and re-construction.
