UPDATE: GPREP Deactivated Following Fire at Industrial Processing Facility

The Grande Prairie Regional Emergency Partnership Emergency Operations Centre has been deactivated.

An early morning fire at an industrial processing facility located in the County of Grande Prairie is now under control.

At approximately 07:15 the Grande Prairie Regional Emergency Partnership (GPREP) was activated in response to a fire at an industrial processing facility located near Highway 672 and Range Road 85.

As a precaution, residents living within a 2.1 km radius of the facility were evacuated and have returned home.

There is no concern for public safety.

The scene is being led by Firemaster Oilfield Services Inc. with support from the County of Grande Prairie Regional Fire Service.

GPREP is an emergency response partnership comprised of six regional municipalities: The County of Grande Prairie, the City of Grande Prairie, the Town of Wembley, the Town of Beaverlodge, the Town of Sexsmith, and Village of Hythe.
