Section of Township Road 734 closed for Bridge Replacement

Starting August 12, Township Road 734, from Highway 43 to Range Road 114, will be reduced to local traffic only to allow for a bridge replacement.

The anticipated completion date is mid-October, weather permitting.

Motorists are advised to detour using Range Road 114 and Highway 43 or Secondary Highway 672 to access Township Road 734 west of the bridge.

Motorists are advised to allow extra time for travel and to obey all signs, flag persons, and exercise extreme caution when travelling through the site and near crews and equipment.

Please see attached for the project map. The solid red line identifies roads impacted by construction and the bridge construction site. The green line offers a suggested traffic detour.

The County thanks residents and travelers for their patience and cooperation while this bridge replacement is underway.

The County is investing a total of \$31.1 million on capital road and bridge projects this year. New construction this year includes 18.4 km of road surfacing including the paving of gravel roads, surfaced road overlays, and re-construction.
