"You're part of a team, you learn new skills, and you make a real difference in your community," said Widsten. "No experience is necessary, and we offer lots of flexibility, so we're willing to work around people's abilities and schedules."

All La Glace firefighters must live within 15 minutes from the La Glace Fire Station.
