Upgrades to 162 Avenue in Clairmont begin next week

Starting Tuesday, September 1, contractors will begin base paving 162 Avenue from west of 102 Street to Range Road 63 in Clairmont.

The anticipated completion date of the project is early October, weather dependent.

Base paving work involves removing the top layer of gravel, repairing the base of the road if needed, then packing of the current road surface, and paving a layer of asphalt. View the project map below to see where the work will take place.

Motorists can expect speed and lane reductions throughout the project. When travelling through construction, obey signage, exercise extreme caution when travelling through the site and near crews and equipment, allow extra time for travel, or use alternate routes.

The County is investing over \$42 million in road construction projects throughout the County, which includes \$2 million to repair roads damaged by spring flooding and \$515,000 in this year's Ditch Cleaning Program.
