## NOTICE OF ADVANCE VOTE

Local Jurisdiction: **COUNTY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE NO. 1**, Province of Alberta

Notice is hereby given:

**A. That an election will be held for the filling of the following offices:**

**B. That an election will be held for the election of a Senate nominee for the purposes of the *Alberta Senate Election Act*;**

**C. That a vote of the electors will be held on the following referendum questions under the *Referendum Act*:**

*Question 1: Equalization*

Should section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982 – Parliament and the government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments – be removed from the constitution?

*Question 2: Daylight Saving Time*

Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?

**ADVANCE VOTING** will take place on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2021, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. and the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2021 between the hours of 11:00 am. and 4:00 p.m. Voting stations will be located at:

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection. The identification must be one or more of the following as required by section 53 of the *Local Authorities Election Act*.

- One piece of photo identification issued by a Canadian government or agency which includes the elector's name and current address (ie. Operator/Driver's License; Government Photo Identification Card (for non-driver's); or
- One piece of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer under the Election Act that establishes the elector's name and current address (ie. Government cheque or cheque stub; property tax notice; insurance policy or coverage card; utility bill, etc.) The complete authorized list can be found online at [www.countygp.ab.ca/elections](http://www.countygp.ab.ca/elections).
- If a voter's identification shows a post office box number as the address instead of a residential or legal address, it can be accepted as verification of current address if it is in reasonable proximity to the voting jurisdiction.
