## SPECIFICATIONS FOR RECREATIONAL FIRE PITS ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES

In the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 where a recreational fire pit is required to be permitted, the following specifications are required.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. The pit is located at a safe distance, approximately 10 feet/3 m, from all combustibles (i.e. house, sheds, fences, trees, decks, power lines, etc.).
- 2. The pit be either dug into the ground, or constructed above ground in a manner which will prevent the fuel from falling out of the container.
- 3. The above ground portion of the pit is constructed of stone, masonry, or metal.
- 4. The fire pit shall have a mesh screen while lit.
- 5. The pit should be no more than 3 feet/1 m in diameter or equivalent size if rectangular.
- Portable manufactured fire pits (including chimineas) shall be located at a safe distance, approximately 10 feet/3 m, from all combustibles (i.e. house, sheds, fences, trees, decks, power lines etc.).
- 7. No portable manufactured fire pit (including chimineas) shall be placed on a combustible surface or structure (i.e. wooden decks).
- 8. Flammable or combustible liquids, chemicals or contaminated substances shall not be burnt.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

The area directly surrounding the pit will be of noncombustible material or cleared to mineral soil.
