



Bylaw # 3175

Rescinding of Hythe Bylaws (3)

A Bylaw of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of rescinding former Village of Hythe bylaws that are irrelevant and/or have subsequent bylaws in place for those matters.

WHEREAS in accordance with Order in Council 168/2021 the Village of Hythe was dissolved and became a hamlet of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 on July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS under the provisions of Order in Council 168/2021, bylaws and resolutions of the village continue to apply in the former area of the Village of Hythe until the bylaws or resolutions are repealed, amended or replaced by the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1; and

WHEREAS there are a number of former Village of Hythe Bylaws that can be repealed because the County of Grande Prairie has a bylaw that addresses the same subject matter or the bylaw is irrelevant;

THEREFORE, the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, duly assembled in the Province of Alberta, hereby enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the “Rescinding of Hythe Bylaws (3) Bylaw”
2. Headings in this Bylaw are for reference purposes only.
3. Words in the masculine gender will include the feminine gender whenever the context so requires and vice versa.
4. Words in the singular shall include the plural or visa versa whenever the context so requires.

BYLAWS TO BE RESCINDED

5. The following bylaws of the former Village of Hythe are hereby rescinded:
 - i. Bylaw 41 – Clearing of Snow and Ice
 - ii. Bylaw 413 – Respecting Waterworks and Sewer
 - iii. Bylaw 428 – Collection and Disposal of Garbage and Refuse in Hythe
 - iv. Bylaw 473 – Control and Regulate the Sale of Municipal Public Utility Services
 - v. Bylaw 517 – Regulate the Sale of Municipal Public Utility Services on Vacant Property
 - vi. Bylaw 545 – Change Rates for Water, Sewer and Solid Waste

SEVERABILITY

6. Each Section of this Bylaw shall be read and construed as being separate and severable from each other Section. Furthermore, should any Section or Part of this Bylaw be found to have been improperly enacted for any reason, then such Section or Part shall be regarded as being severable from the rest of the Bylaw and the Bylaw remaining after such severance shall be effective and enforceable.

EFFECTIVE DATE

7. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third and final reading thereof.

Read a FIRST time this 10th Day of January 2022.

Read a SECOND time this 10th Day of January 2022.

Read a THIRD and FINAL time this 10th Day of January 2022.
