Policy Purpose

To provide policy for processing gravel donation requests from Community Facilities within the County of Grande Prairie.

Policy Statement

The County encourages community development, well-being, and improved quality of life by supporting community facilities through fiscally responsible initiatives.

Definitions

“Community Facilities” means public or semi-public places where members of a community gather for recreational, educational, social, or cultural purposes, or locations co-operatively or municipally owned and used for joint economic benefit.

“County” means the municipality of the County of Grande Prairie No.1 having jurisdiction under the Municipal Government Act and other applicable legislation;

Policy Guidelines

1. The County will provide an amount of gravel approved by the Director of Public Works, or designate, to a maximum of sixty-five (65) tonnes every other year, per Community Facility within the County.
2. The gravel will be supplied from County sources.
3. Gravel will be delivered by County forces on a timeline determined by the County.
4. Spreading and placement of the gravel shall be the responsibility of the recipient.
