Policy Purpose

To provide direction for the processing of requests for directional signing to named subdivisions located within the County of Grande Prairie No.1.

Policy Statement

The County of Grande Prairie provides clear and consistent signage that meets citizens needs and guides vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

Definitions

"Named Subdivision" means any subdivision consisting of six (6) or more lots that has been given a name through Council motion.

Policy Guidelines

- 1. The County may, upon written request to the Director of Public Works, provide directional signs with the subdivision name thereon, to Named Subdivisions from the nearest County owned collector or arterial road. A maximum of four (4) signs per subdivision will be provided and placed at the discretion of the Public Works Department.
- 2. The County will not place any signs within rights-of-way owned by Alberta Transportation, requests for such must be made to Alberta Transportation directly.
- 3. The County sign shop is responsible for ordering, installing, and maintaining approved signs.
