

BYLAW # 3235



Road Closure of Portion of Undeveloped Government Road Allowance Adjoining the West Boundary of SW-24-70-5-W6 Bylaw

A bylaw of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing and leasing a portion of undeveloped Government road allowance adjoining the west boundary of SW-24-70-5-W6 in accordance with Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended.

WHEREAS: the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS: an application has been made to Council to have the road closed and leased, and

WHEREAS: the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No.1 deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel and leasing certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and

WHEREAS: notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with section 606 Municipal Government Act, and

WHEREAS: the Council was not petitioned during a Public Hearing for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, in the Province of Alberta, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the following described road is closed to public travel for the purpose of disposing subject rights of access granted by other legislation:

MERIDIAN 6 RANGE 5 TOWNSHIP 70

ALL THAT PORTION OF THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE
ADJOINING THE MOST NORTHERN 600 METERS OF THE WEST BOUNDARY
OF THE S.W.24-70-5-W6 CONTAINING 2.99 ACRES MORE OR LESS.
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

INTERPRETATION

2. This Bylaw shall be cited as the "Road Closure of Portion of Undeveloped Government Road Allowance Adjoining the West Boundary of SW-24-70-5-W6 Bylaw".

3. Headings in this Bylaw are for reference purposes only.
4. Words in the masculine gender will include the feminine gender whenever the context so requires and vice versa.
5. Words in the singular shall include the plural or vice versa whenever the context so requires.

SEVERABILITY

6. Every provision of this bylaw is independent of all other provisions and if any provision is declared invalid by a Court, then the invalid provisions shall be severed and the remainder provisions shall remain valid and enforceable.

EFFECTIVE DATE

7. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third and final reading thereof.

PUBLIC HEARING held this 9th day of September, 2024.

READ a first time this 9th day of September, 2024.




