WHEREAS Notice of Intention of the Council to pass a by-law has been published once a week for 2 consecutive weeks, in a newspaper circulating in the area to which the proposed bylaw relates, the last of such publications being at least five days before the day fixed for the passing of the by-law, and

WHEREAS Notice of Intention of the Council to pass a by-law has been mailed or delivered to every residence in the area to which the proposed bylaw relates, and

WHEREAS a Public Hearing has been held to hear comments from any person wishing to be heard who may be prejudicially affected by the by-law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 does hereby close to public travel and dispose of the following described highway, subject to right of access granted by other legislation or regulations:
