

BYLAW # 3237

City of Grande Prairie / County of Grande Prairie Intermunicipal Development Plan Bylaw

A bylaw of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 in the Province of Alberta to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan between the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 and the City of Grande Prairie in accordance with provisions of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c. M-26 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS: pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c. M-26 and amendments thereto, a Council must pass a bylaw to adopt an Intermunicipal Development Plan with municipalities that have common boundaries; and

WHEREAS: the County of Grande Prairie wishes to establish an Intermunicipal Development Plan with the City of Grande Prairie.

WHEREAS: notice of the proposed Bylaw and Public Hearing was given pursuant to Section 606(2) of the Municipal Government Act.

WHEREAS: a Public Hearing was scheduled and held pursuant to Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, in the Province of Alberta, hereby enacts as follows:

INTERPRETATION

- 1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the City of Grande Prairie / County of Grande Prairie Intermunicipal Development Plan Bylaw.
- 2. Headings in this Bylaw are for reference purposes only.
- 3. Words in the masculine gender will include the feminine gender whenever the context so requires and vice versa.
- 4. Words in the singular shall include the plural or vice versa whenever the context so requires.

DEFINITIONS

- 5. In this Bylaw:
 - 5.1. "CAO" means the person appointed by Council to the position of Chief Administrative Officer or County Manager under the Municipal Government Act for the County or designate.
 - 5.2. "County" means the municipality of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 having jurisdiction under the Municipal Government Act and other applicable legislation.

GENERAL

- 6. That the City of Grande Prairie / County of Grande Prairie Intermunicipal Development Plan and its attachments, shown as Schedule "A" are hereby adopted as part of this Bylaw.
- 7. That the provisions of this Bylaw apply to all lands within the area outlined with a red dashed line on the Intermunicipal Development Plan Map 2, Plan Area.

SEVERABILITY

8. Every provision of this bylaw is independent of all other provisions and if any provision is declared invalid by a Court, then the invalid provisions shall be severed and the remainder provisions shall remain valid and enforceable.

REPEAL

9. Bylaw #2896 and amendments thereto are hereby rescinded.

EFFECTIVE DATE

- 10. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third and final reading thereof.
- 11. City of Grande Prairie / County of Grande Prairie Intermunicipal Development Plan shall come into force once the City and the County give third readings to their respective bylaws.
