Policy Purpose

To provide policy for processing gravel donation requests from Community Facilities within the County.

Policy Statement

The County encourages community development, well-being, and improved quality of life by supporting community facilities through fiscally responsible initiatives.

Definitions

“Community Facilities” means public or semi-public places where members of a community gather for recreational, educational, social, or cultural purposes.

“County” means the municipal corporation of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 having jurisdiction under the Municipal Government Act and other applicable legislation.

Policy Guidelines

1. The County will provide an amount of gravel approved by the General Manager of Transportation and Utilities, or designate, to a maximum of approximately seventy tonnes.
2. Community Facilities may receive gravel once every other year.
3. Gravel will be delivered by the County on a timeline determined by the County.
4. Spreading and placement of the gravel shall be the responsibility of the recipient.
