Bylaw # 3142



"Public Utility Lot Designation Bylaw"

Bylaw Statement:

A Bylaw of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of the designation of municipal land, in accordance with Section 665 of the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, Chapter M-26.

WHEREAS: Council may by bylaw, pursuant to s.665 of the Municipal Government Act, require that a parcel of land or a part of a parcel of land which the County in is the process of acquiring be designated as a public utility lot;

WHEREAS: The County has reached a conditional agreement with 1965856 Alberta Ltd., the owner of Lot 74, Block 1, Plan 8921992 to acquire a portion of the land;

WHEREAS: The Plan of Survey attached to this Bylaw as Schedule "A" prepared by Helix Surveys Ltd. identifies the part of the Parcel to be designated as public utility lot.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The part of the Parcel identified as Lot 131 PUL on the Plan Survey attached to this Bylaw as Schedule "A" is to be designated as public utility lot.
- 2. The Registrar at Alberta Land Titles is requested to, in accordance with s. 665 of the Municipal Government Act, do all things necessary to give effect to this bylaw.

INTERPRETATION

- 1. This Bylaw shall be cited as the Public Utility Lot Designation Bylaw.
- 2. Headings in this Bylaw are for reference purposes only.
- 3. Words in the masculine gender will include the feminine gender whenever the context so requires and vice versa.
- 4. Words in the singular shall include the plural or vice versa whenever the context so requires.

SEVERABILITY

Each Section of this Bylaw shall be read and construed as being separate and severable from each other Section. Furthermore, should any Section or Part of this Bylaw be found to have been improperly enacted for any reason, then such Section or Part shall be regarded as being severable from the rest of the Bylaw and the Bylaw remaining after such severance shall be effective and enforceable.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third reading thereof.
