

BYLAW 3196

West Grande Prairie Solid Waste Authority Bylaw



A bylaw of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 in the Province of Alberta to authorize entering into an agreement with participating local authorities within the boundaries of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, to provide for the joint establishment and operation of a regional solid waste management system.

WHEREAS: pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, as amended, Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property, and services provided by or on behalf of the municipality, and public utilities; and

WHEREAS: in the interest of minimizing potential damage to the environment from improper refuse disposal, the participating municipalities wish to establish a regional waste management system to serve all participating municipalities; and

WHEREAS: the participating municipalities be authorized to enter into an agreement to establish and maintain a joint committee to be known as the West Grande Prairie Solid Waste Authority (the "Authority") for the construction, maintenance, control, operation, and use of a regional waste management system.

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, the Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, in the Province of Alberta, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Town of Wembley, the Town of Beaverlodge and the Town of Sexsmith ("participating municipalities") to establish and maintain the West Grande Prairie Solid Waste Authority (the "Authority") and provide for the following:
 - a. Organizational requirements;
 - b. Operations and management;
 - c. Financing; and
 - d. General provisions and guidelines.
2. The representatives of the County authorized to represent the County on the Authority shall be four (4) members of County Council, as appointed by Council to the Authority.
3. Bylaws 1874 and 2768 and all amendments thereto are hereby rescinded.

EFFECTIVE DATE


This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third and final reading thereof.
